Early-stage individuals:

• are aware of changes in ability to remember recent events

• can perform simple daily routines and communicate with others.

• may have some problems related to:

- memory loss and confusion, such as to time and place .
- getting lost in familiar surroundings.
- changes in personality and judgment.
- loss of initiative and apathy, or irritation and moodiness.
- problems with abstract thinking.
